

Mercedes-Benz Museum

Traffic guidance system:



Follow directions to the Gottlieb-Daimler-Stadium or follow



these symbols on the NeckarPark traffic guidance system.

Arrival by car:

■ On the motorway A8 coming from Karlsruhe to the Stuttgart motorway junction, "Vaihingen" exit. From here onto the A831, then on the B14 in the direction of "Stuttgart-Zentrum" (Stuttgart center) and continue on the B10/B14 following the signs to "NeckarPark" as well as the symbol to the Mercedes-Benz Museum.

■ On the motorway A8 coming from Ulm to the "Esslingen-Zentrum" (Esslingen center) exit, continue on the B313, then on the B10 in the direction of Stuttgart to the "Stuttgart-Ost" (Stuttgart East) exit; from there follow the signs to "NeckarPark" as well as the symbol to the Mercedes-Benz Museum.

■ On the motorway A81 coming from Heilbronn to the "Zuffenhausen" exit, continue on the B10 in the direction of "Stuttgart-Zentrum" (Stuttgart center), following the signs to "NeckarPark" in the direction of Stuttgart-Bad Cannstatt/ Esslingen and the symbol to the Mercedes-Benz Museum.

Parking:

Please use either the museum car park or the neighboring P4 car park. (Car park P4 has no disabled parking bays and is not equipped with elevators.)

Buses and minibuses over 1.90 m in height should park in the bus parking bays behind the Mercedes-Benz Center.

Parking in the museum car park and in car park P4 is free to visitors to the Mercedes-Benz Museum for the first three hours of their stay. For the fourth to sixth hours inclusive a parking fee of € 2 per hour will be charged. From the seventh hour the parking fee rises to € 4 per hour.

Disabled parking bays are provided for our disabled visitors in the museum car park. These can be found on level EG close to the ticket machines and glass doors. Wheelchair users are requested to follow signs for the elevator.

We extend a particular welcome to visitors arriving by classic car. If you wish you may park your classic vehicle on the hill outside the main entrance to the museum. The same applies to disabled vehicles over 1.90 m in height.

During VfB Stuttgart's home matches and other major events access to the Mercedes-Benz Museum may be restricted. In such circumstances we recommend the use of public transport.

Arrival by train:

From Stuttgart main station take the S-Bahn (rapid transit system) line S1 in the direction of Plochingen/Esslingen to Gottlieb-Daimler-Stadium. On leaving the train, follow signs to the museum.

Arrival by bus:

Bad Cannstatt station is served by S-Bahn lines S1, S2 and S3 as well as by the regional rail network and RegionalExpress. Bus line 51 connects Bad Cannstatt station with Mercedes-Benz World (departs daily from 8.30 a.m. to 10.00 p.m.)

Opening times:

Open 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. – ticket desk closes at 5.00 p.m. The museum is open from Tuesday to Sunday and on public holidays. It is closed on Mondays, also when a public holiday falls on a Monday.

Shops and restaurants:

You are welcome to shop, walk around and enjoy the premises during opening hours without visiting the museum.

The museum has facilities for disabled visitors. When visiting the exhibition, children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Dogs are not allowed in the exhibition rooms.

Baby-changing facilities are available in all seven disabled toilets. You will find a special toilet for children next to the café-bar.

Factory tour:

Guided tours of the Motorenwerk Untertürkheim facility can be arranged for museum visitors from Tuesday to Friday. This is a production site for major assemblies, where engines, transmissions and axles are manufactured. It is therefore not possible to see cars being assembled here.

For insurance reasons, we regret that only visitors over the age of 16 are permitted to take part in the factory tours. Please bring appropriate footwear.

Tickets for the factory tour can be booked in the museum on the day of your visit depending on availability. Advance bookings are not possible. Tickets for factory tours cannot be sent by post. Tours in German commence at 11.45 a.m. and in English at 1.45 p.m.

Tickets for groups:

You will receive your tickets upon payment on the day of your visit. Please contact staff at the information desk for further details.

Guided tours for groups:

Guided tours for groups can be organized by appointment (approx. 75 minutes duration). Tour cost for groups of up to 20 people: 60 euros (does not include entrance).

To ensure that your guided tour can be organized at your preferred time we advise you make an appointment for your group at least three to four weeks in advance of your visit.

In addition, electronic audio-guides featuring a wide selection of languages are provided free of charge for groups wishing to explore the museum without a personal tour guide.

Architectural tour:

On request we can also arrange architectural tours for visitors with a specialist interest.

Information for bus drivers:

Bus drivers and group tour guides are offered free entry to the museum. Tickets will be provided at the information desk.

Parking for buses:

Parking bays for seven buses are available in Mercedes-Jellinek-Straße, directly adjacent to the premises of the Mercedes-Benz Museum.
